1.1 InstaCmStick: CodeMeter definitions

To protect the GGU software from unauthorised access, each GGU program is equipped with the CodeMeter software protection system from WIBU-Systems. Each GGU program is bound to a so-called CmContainer via a license with the corresponding product code.

To be able to use the GGU licenses in a CmContainer, a runtime environment, the *CodeMeter Runtime Kit*, must be installed on your computer via driver software. By default, the *CodeMeter Runtime Server* is installed as a service on your PC and displayed via the Cm-icon



in the right-hand area of your taskbar. You can manage your CmContainer and the GGU licenses activated in it using the *CodeMeter Control Center* and *CodeMeter WebAdmin* tools installed with it.

To be simplified, we will refer to your computer with installed CodeMeter Runtime Kit and CmContainer as the *CodeMeter license server*.

We provide 3 alternative CmContainer types that can be used on your CodeMeter license server:

CmStick

The license for your GGU program is stored in a USB dongle.

CmActLicense (soft license, not for virtual PC/servers)

The license for your GGU program is stored in a license file that is bound to the hardware of a computer.

CmCloudContainer

The license for your GGU program is located on a CmCloud server of WIBU-Systems and is mirrored to your CodeMeter license server.

In the following descriptions, the superordinate term *CmContainer* may be used to represent all 3 types of containers.

The GGU programs check at start-up and during runtime whether a corresponding license is available on a CmContainer. If the GGU licenses are to be accessed by different clients in the company network, the CodeMeter license server must be set up as a *network server* (see point 3).

1.2 InstaCmStick: Installation of the CodeMeter Runtime Kit

To enable your GGU programs to access the licenses, the CodeMeter Runtime Kit must be installed on the CodeMeter license server to which the CmStick is plugged in and, in the case of network licenses, on each client computer on which the GGU programs are used.

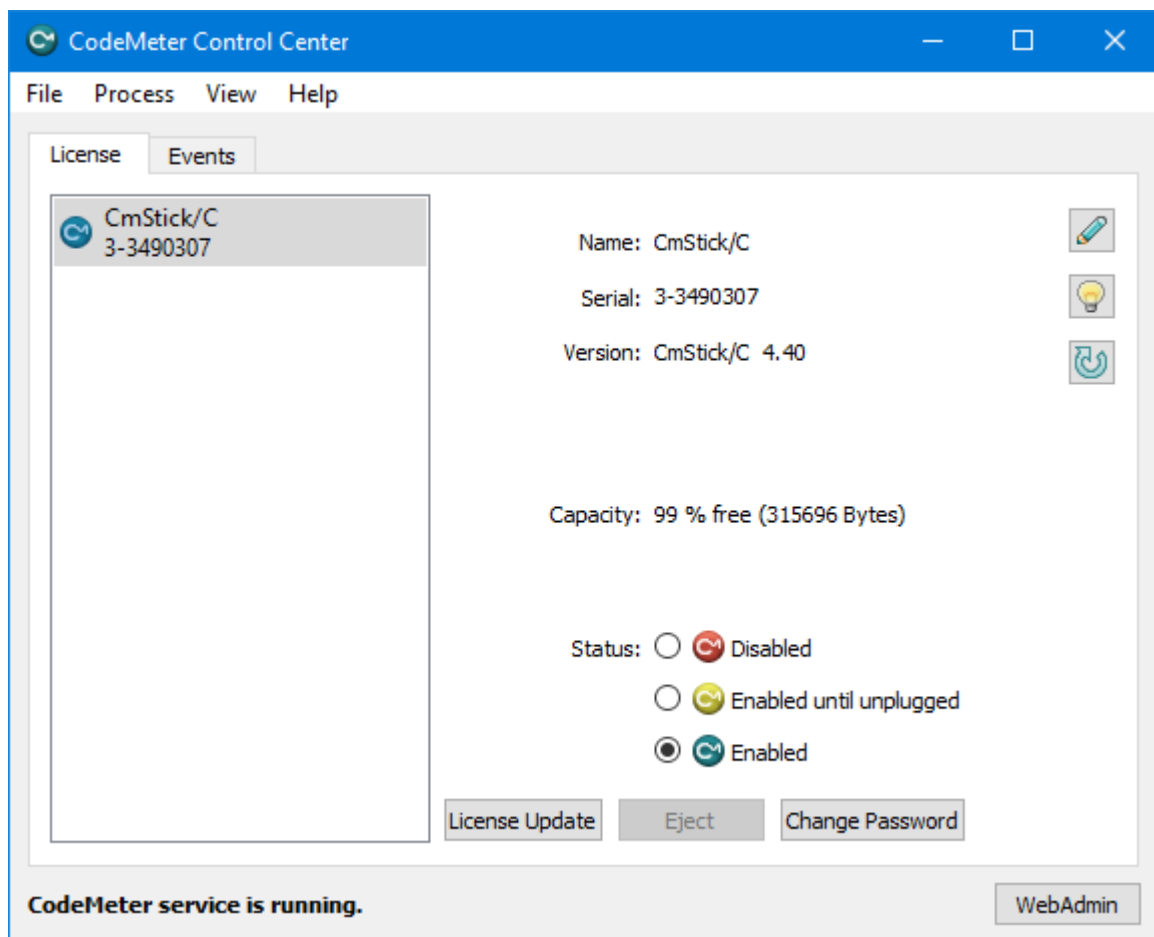
Note: Administrator's rights for installation of the CodeMeter Runtime Kit are necessary with operating systems such as Windows 8, 10 and 11.

After installation, the CodeMeter Runtime Server service starts automatically with the Cm icon



in the right area of your taskbar. To access your CmStick, open the CodeMeter Control Center by clicking on the Cm icon or via "Start/All Programs/CodeMeter/CodeMeter Control Center".

The following program window will open, showing you information about your CmStick, among others name, serial number and version of the firmware. The firmware is a programming directly on your CmStick for which updates can be retrieved from the server of the manufacturer WIBU-Systems via the button with the circle arrow symbol.



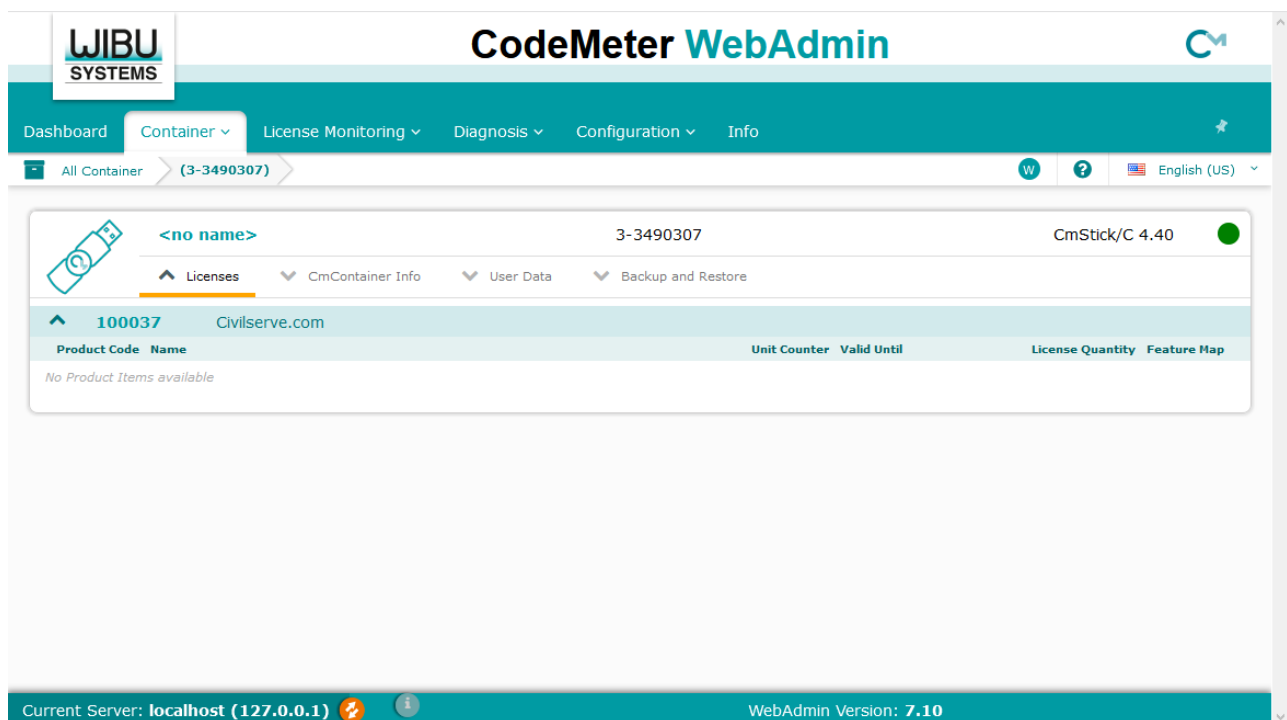
1.3 InstaCmStick: Setup of a network server (CodeMeter license server in the network)

If your GGU programs are activated as network licenses (Floating Network License = FNL) on your CmStick and are to be accessed by various clients in the company network, first install the CodeMeter Runtime Kit on the CodeMeter license server as described in point 2. *During the installation, make sure that the server functions are activated.*

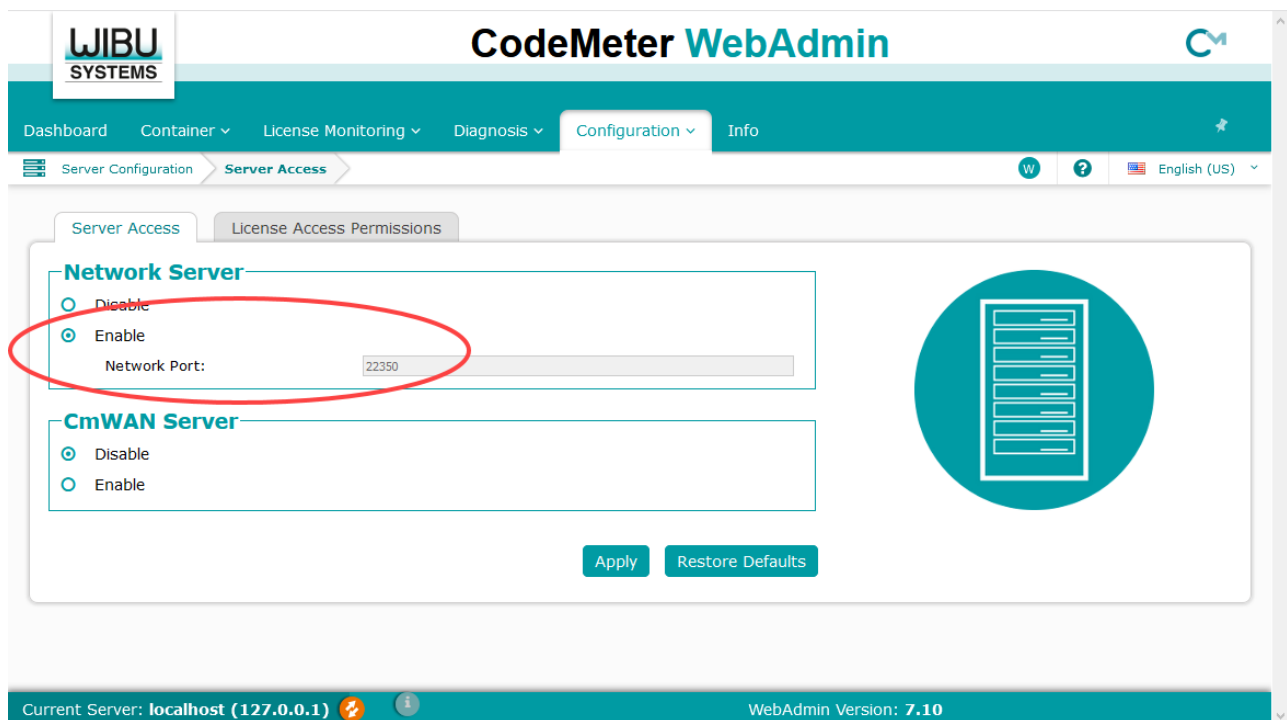
Afterwards, check or perform the network settings. To do this, open the CodeMeter WebAdmin by clicking the right mouse button on the Cm-icon



in the right area of your taskbar and selecting it in the context menu. Alternatively, click the "WebAdmin" button in the CodeMeter Control Center. The following browser window appears:



To enable your client computers to access the GGU licenses on your CmStick via the network, the network server must be activated in the "Configuration" menu sub-item "Server/Server Access". The network port will be set automatically (see figure below). Then click on "Apply".

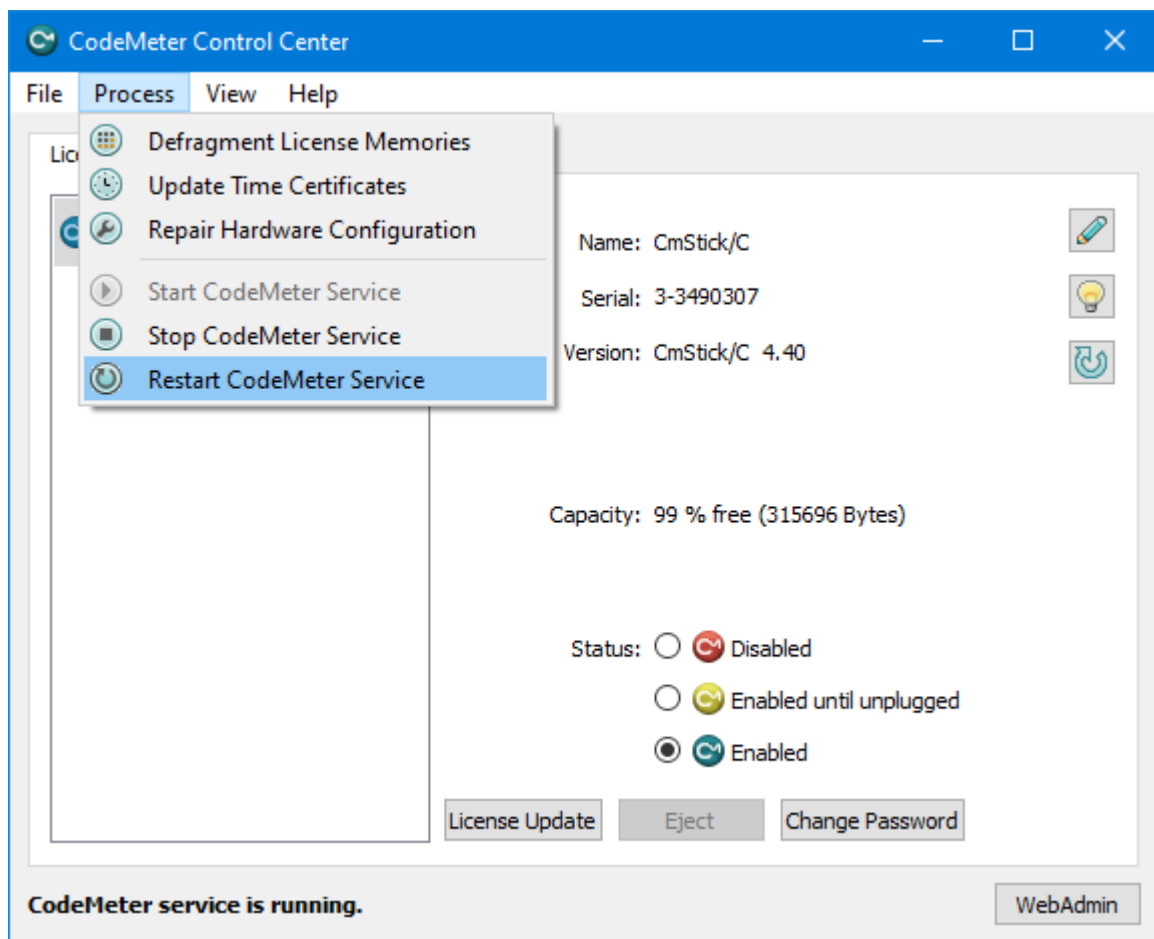


Note: CodeMeter license server uses TCP/IP network protocol and default port 22350 for communication, so this port must not be blocked by your firewall. Make sure that the used IP port 22350 is freely usable for CodeMeter, i.e., release the communication for this IP port in your firewall.

Now open the CodeMeter control center by double-clicking on the Cm-icon



in your taskbar. Click on the menu item "Restart CodeMeter service" under the menu title "Process". After restarting, your server setup is complete.



The CodeMeter Runtime Kit must also be installed *on the client computers*.

For *network access to the GGU licences* using WAN (Wide Area Network) via VPN or similar, it is essential that the IP of your network server is entered in CodeMeter WebAdmin of the client computer under "Configuration/Basis/ Server search list".

In the LAN (Local Area Network), entry is often not necessary, as the CmContainer with the GGU licences will be automatically searched for if no CmContainer is found locally at the client computer.

1.4 InstaCmStick: GGU software licence activation on your CmStick (optional)

If you have not already received your CmStick programmed, you have been sent an email from Civilserve or Cleverbridge/WIBU- Systems AG in which you can find your personal link with a ticket number for downloading and activating the licenses on your CmStick:

Launch the ticket link on your CodeMeter license server directly from your email or by copying it into your internet browser. The corresponding page in the "CodeMeter License Central WebDepot" opens. You will see the GGU licenses displayed which can be imported via this ticket, in the following image the license for the GGU-RETAIN program.

Select the serial number of your CmStick, which must be plugged in for programming. If several CmSticks are plugged in, first select the desired stick in the pull-down menu. If you are only plugging in the CmStick now, first update with the button and then make your selection. To activate the GGU licenses, then click on the yellow "Activate selected licenses now" button. The transfer may take several seconds, please be patient. The browser window can then simply be closed.

If several purchased GGU licenses are to be activated on *different CmSticks*, first mark the desired program (check mark set) and select the desired CmStick. After clicking on "Activate selected licenses now", only the selected GGU program will be transferred to the selected CmStick. Then repeat the activation for the next program license.

1.5 InstaCmStick: GGU software license management in WebAdmin

When you start CodeMeter WebAdmin, the "Container" menu with an overview of the GGU licenses entered is displayed first.

If you have connected several CmContainers, first select the required CmContainer to display the license overview.

1.6 InstaCmStick: Installation of the GGU programs (individual installations)

For installation of GGU programs download the current installation file (e.g., "GGU-RETAIN_11.exe") from our download page <https://www.ggu-software.com/en/ggu-software-edelivery>. Double-click to start the installation process.

After completion of the GGU installation, the GGU program files are installed by default in the newly created "C:\Program Files (x86)\GGU-Software\" directory of your computer and some icons are added to the start menu.

Note: When starting the GGU programs later, they access the license entries on your CmContainer. The CodeMeter Runtime Kit must therefore be installed and your CmContainer must be accessible on the CodeMeter license server.

1.7 InstaCmStick: Updates & Bugfixes for the GGU programs

For updates *within your main versions*, you can download the current installation routines free of charge from our download page at any time. The new sub-versions are installed as updates via the installation files.

An update to a *new main version* is a chargeable update. Please ask for an individual update quotation. Before installing a new main version, please uninstall the older main version via the Windows Control Panel.

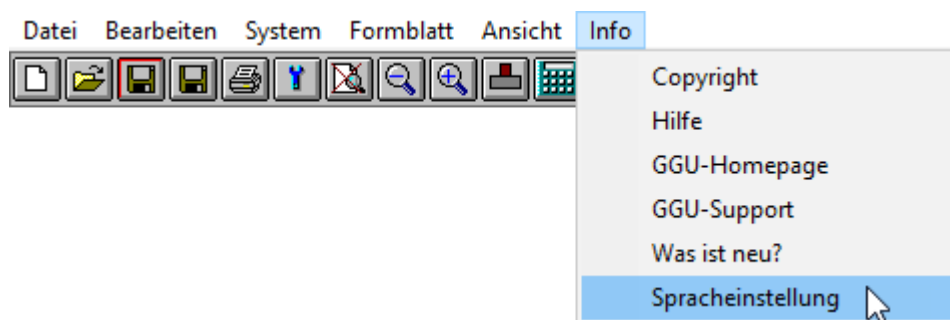

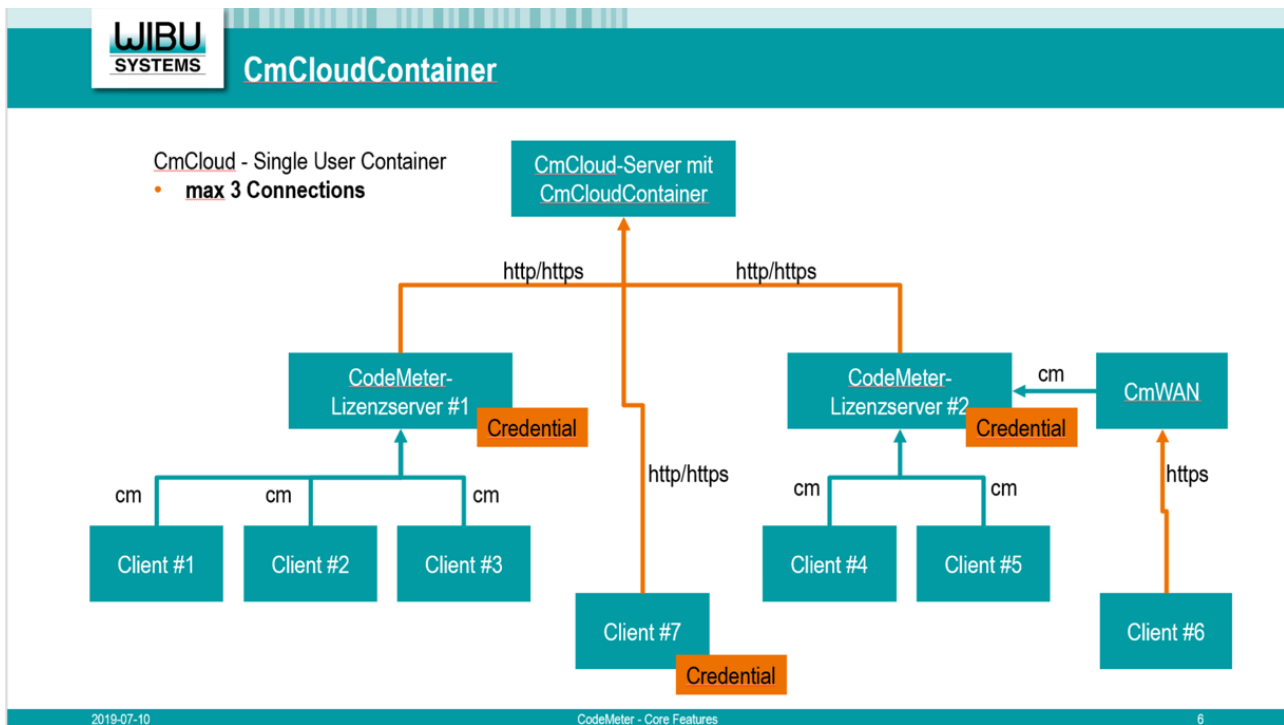

2.2 InstaCmCloud: Installation of the CodeMeter Runtime Kit and mirroring of the CmCloudContainer

Note: For the use of GGU licenses in a CmCloudContainer a functioning HTTP/HTTPS communication from the CodeMeter license server to the CmCloud server of WIBU-Systems must be guaranteed!

Clients in a network do not require an Internet connection.

To enable your GGU programs to access the licenses, the CodeMeter Runtime Kit must be installed on the CodeMeter license server to which the CmCloudContainer is mirrored and, in the case of network licenses, on each client computer on which the GGU programs are used.

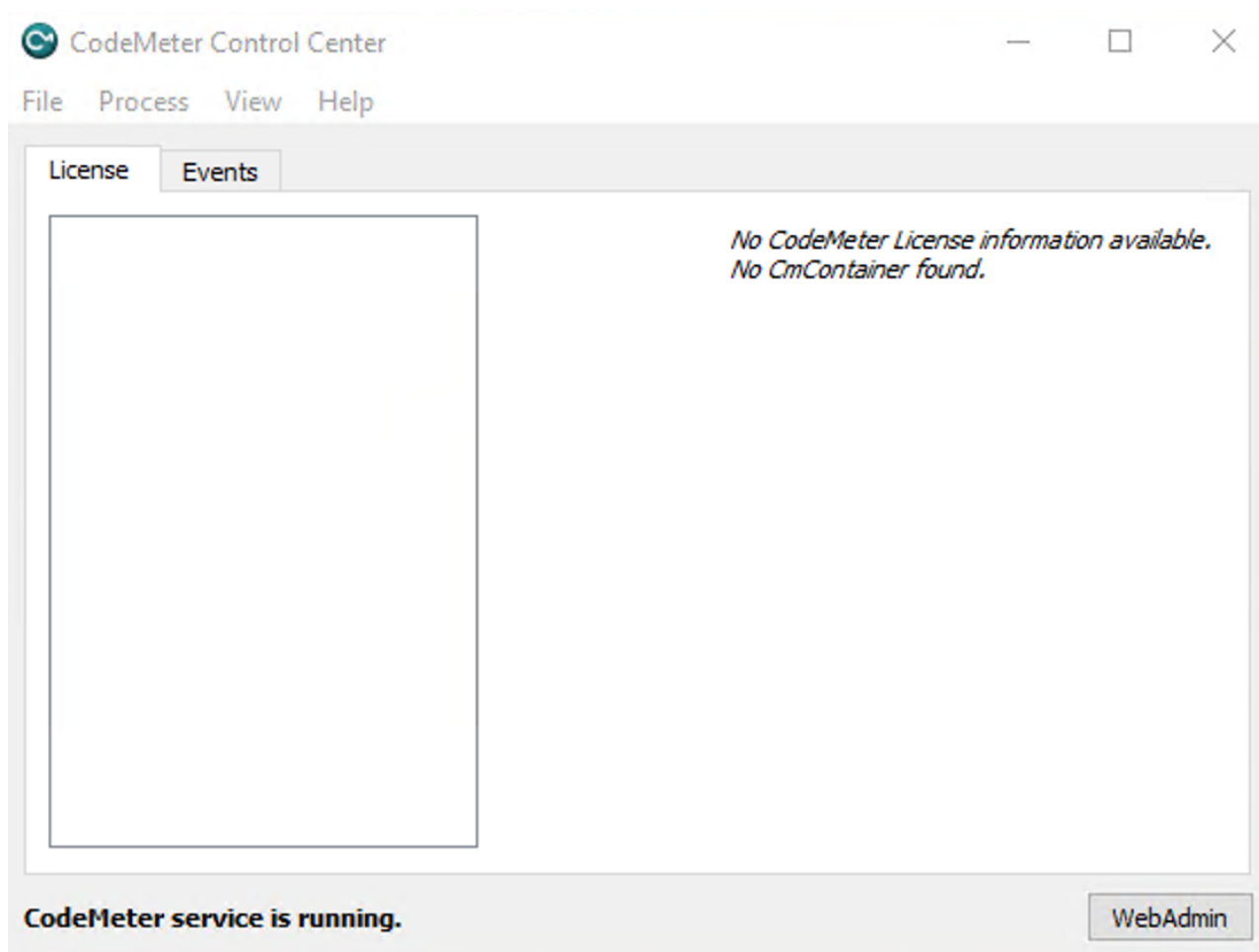

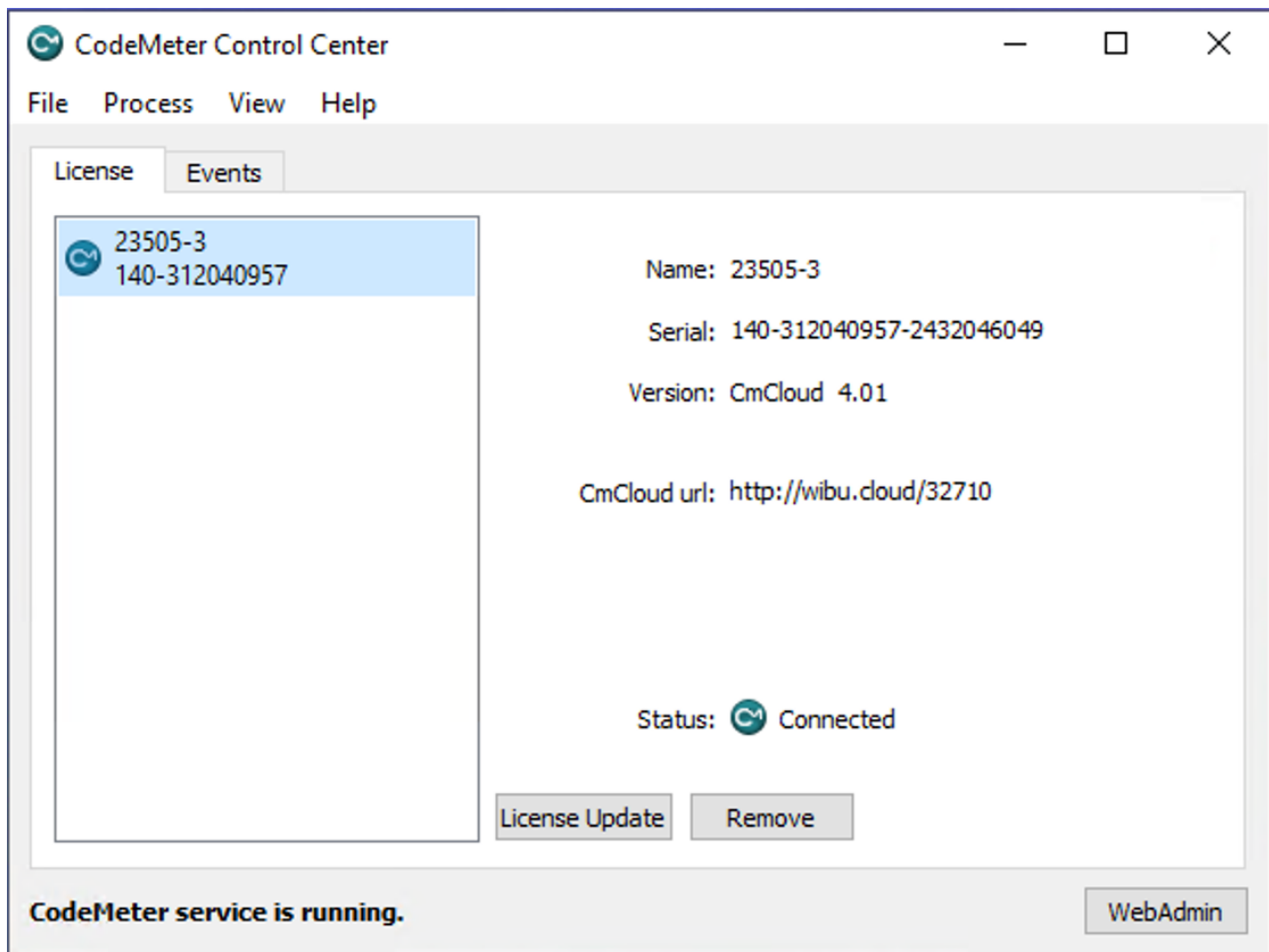


We have created a CmCloudContainer for you on the CmCloud server of WIBU-Systems, to which your customer number is assigned as name as well as an individual serial number. To enable you to work with the CmCloudContainer and to activate GGU licenses on it, a virtual mirroring is carried out on your CodeMeter license server.

To mirror your CmCloudContainer, you have received the CodeMeter "Credential" file (e.g., 140-312040957.wbc) from us by email. Drag and drop this file onto the window of the CodeMeter Control Center.

In the License tab the virtual mirror of your CmCloudContainer is now set up (= CmCloudContainer "mirror"). You will see the name and serial number displayed (see following figure). The licenses of your GGU programs will be entered on your CmCloudContainer in a later step.

Info: You can set up two more virtual mirrors on computers at further locations with the same credential file. When a GGU program is started, the GGU licenses later activated in the CmCloudContainer are occupied by API calls on the CmCloud server of WIBU-Systems until the respective program is closed.



2.3 InstaCmCloud: Setup of a network server (CodeMeter license server in the network)

If your GGU programs are activated as network licenses (Floating Network License = FNL) on your CmCloudContainer and are to be accessed by various clients in the company network, first install the CodeMeter Runtime Kit on the CodeMeter license server and mirror the CmCloudContainer as described in point 2.

Then open the CodeMeter WebAdmin by clicking the right mouse button on the Cm-icon

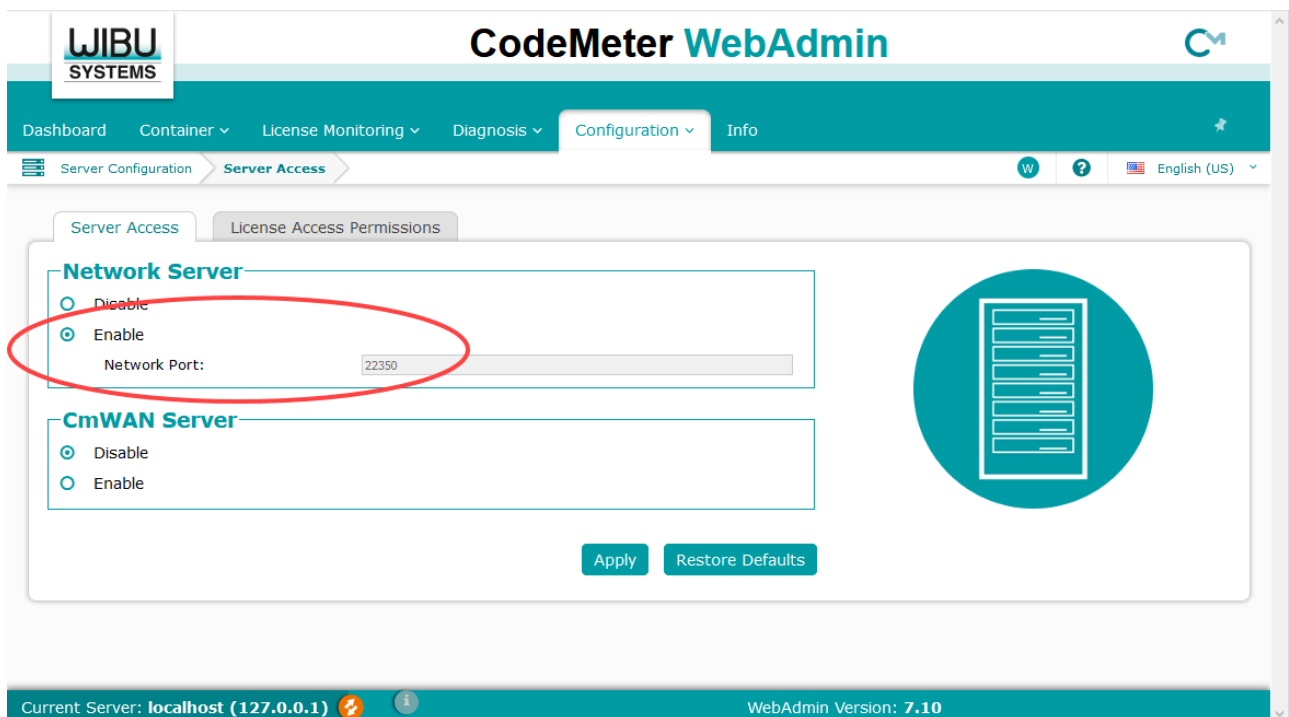


in the right area of your taskbar and selecting it in the context menu. Alternatively, click the "WebAdmin" button in the bottom right corner of the CodeMeter Control Center. The following browser window appears:



To enable your clients to access the GGU licenses in your CmCloudContainer via the network, you must activate the network server in the menu "Configuration" subitem "Server/Server Access". The network port will be set auto-matically (see figure below). Then click on "Apply".

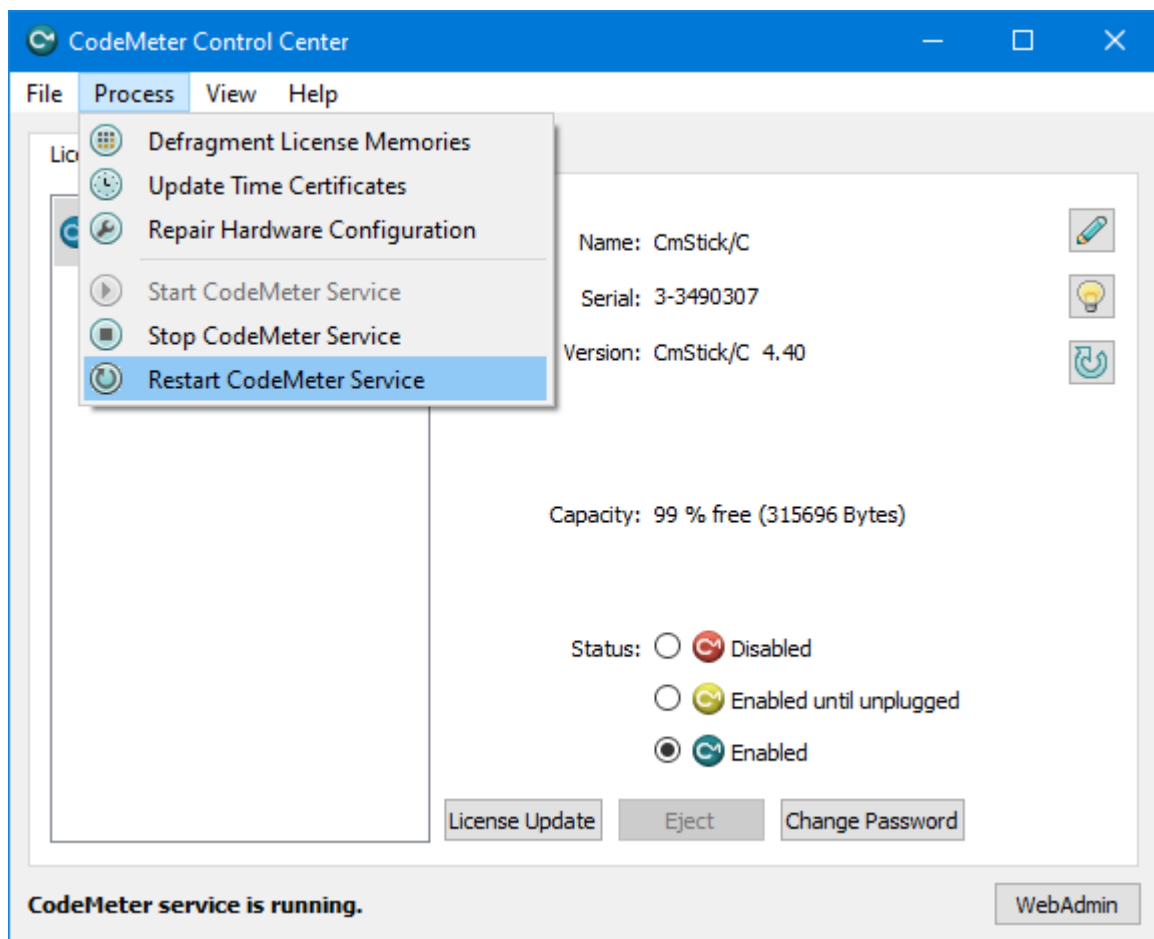

Now open the CodeMeter control center by double-clicking on the Cm-icon



in your taskbar. Click on the menu item "Restart CodeMeter service" under the menu title "Process". After restarting, your server setup is complete.

2.4 InstaCmCloud: GGU software license activation on your CmCloudContainer

For the license activations of your GGU programs, you will receive an email from Civilserve or from Cleverbridge/WIBU-Systems AG containing your personal link with a ticket number to activate the licenses on your CmCloudContainer:

Info: This activation only must be done on one CmCloudContainer "mirror". The other two optionally usable CmCloudContainer "mirrors" will receive the licenses automatically after updating your CmCloudContainer, which is located on the CmCloud server at WIBU-Systems.

Start the ticket link on your CodeMeter license server directly from your email or by copying it into your internet browser. The corresponding page opens in the "CodeMeter License Central WebDepot". You will see the GGU licenses displayed which can be imported via this ticket, in the following image the license for the GGU-RETAIN program.

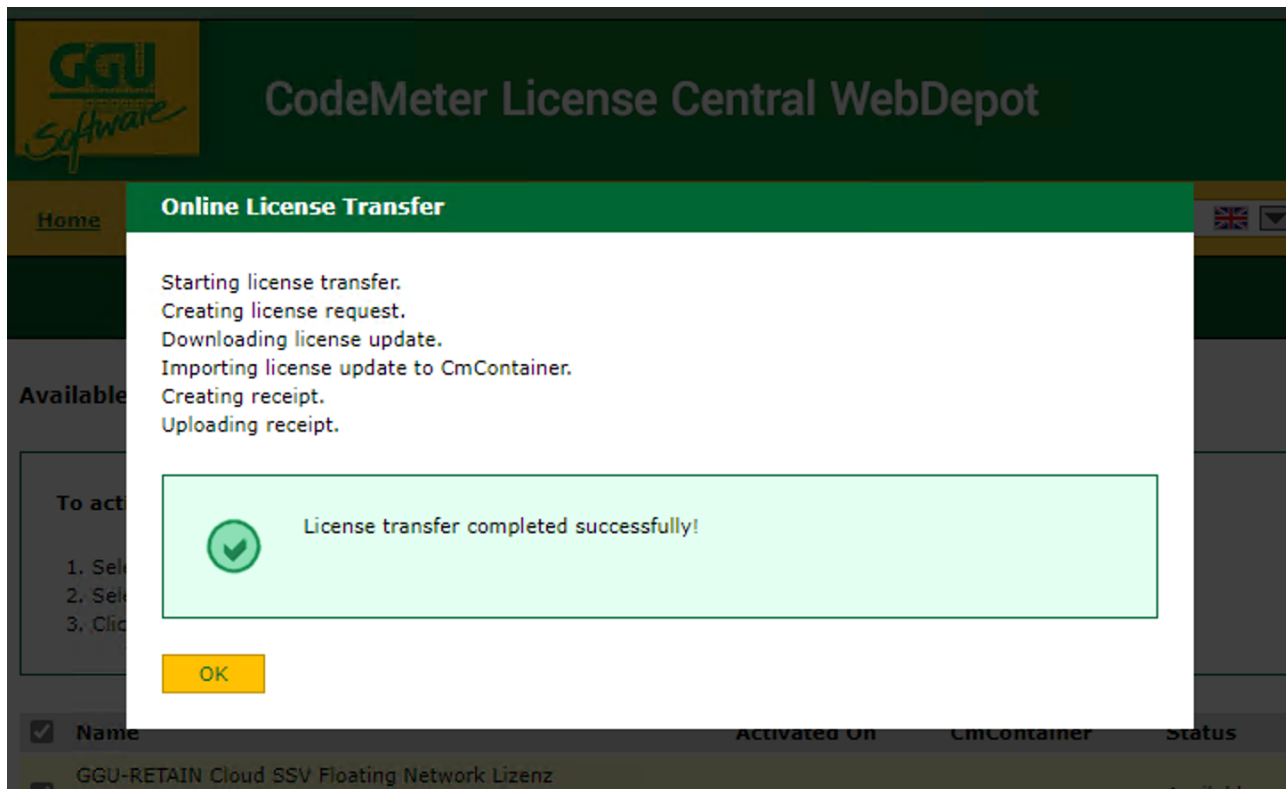

If several purchased GGU licenses are to be activated on *different* CmContainers , first mark the desired program (tick) and select the corresponding CmContainer. After clicking on "Activate Selected Licenses Now", only the selected GGU program is transferred to the selected CmContainer. Then repeat the activation for the next program license.



After the license transfer has been completed, an overview of the GGU licenses now entered is displayed in the "Container" menu when you start CodeMeter WebAdmin. If you have connected several CmContainers, first select the desired CmContainer to display the license overview.

If you click on the product code of an occupied license, further details about the user and the open session are displayed. 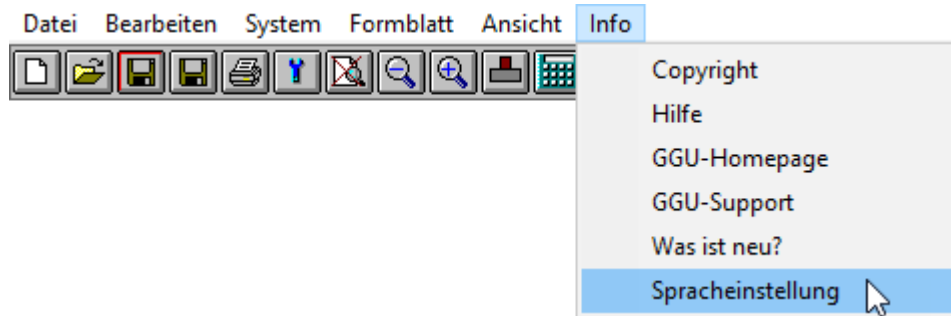

3 Handling Licence binding CmActLicense

3.1 InstaCmAct: Activate a CmActLicense and install the GGU software

To activate and install the GGU software via a CmActLicense, proceed as follows:

1. **CodeMeter: Install/update CodeMeter Runtime Kit (if required)**

At least version 7.10a of the CodeMeter Runtime Kit (CodeMeter License Management Driver) is required to use the GGU software.

For a new installation or update to the latest version of your CodeMeter Runtime Kit, download and run the installation file (32 and 64 bit) from the Internet:

1. **CodeMeter: License activation**

In order to transfer a CmActLicense to your computer, please first open the Internet page via the software link sent to you by cleverbridge/WIBU Systems AG (for example:

The first time a CmActLicense is activated on your computer, the CmContainer is fetched automatically, i.e. a container number is assigned to your computer. If a CmActLicense has already been activated on this computer, the number assigned to the computer at that time is displayed, e.g. 130-259542004 (see figure on page 5).

Click on the yellow "Activate Selected Licenses Now" button. The progress of the online license transfer is displayed in a message box, which you exit via the "OK" button after successful license transfer. The browser window can then simply be closed.

1. GGU-Software: Installation

The installation routines for your GGU licences are available to download in our eDelivery zone at the following address:

Start the installation routines by double-clicking the files after downloading.

In the case of subsequent updates, restart the installation routine for the respective GGU program. The installation program calibrates the files of the previously installed programs and replaces numerous older files.

If you are updating to a new major version, we recommend first uninstalling the old major version via Control Panel/Add or Remove Programs.

3.3 InstaCmAct: Restoring a CmActLicense on the same machine

You may not be able to return your CmActLicense because you did not have access to your computer at short notice (hardware defect). In this case, it is possible to restore your CmActLicense on this computer after a new operating system has been installed, for example.

The current version of the CodeMeter Runtime Kit (CodeMeter license management driver) must first be installed on the newly installed computer. To do this, download and run the installation file (32 and 64 bit) from the Internet:

You must accept the conditions so that you can use the then active button to restore your computer as a CmContainer and have the CmActlicense entered for the GGU software.



4 Full/partial installation – an alternative using Chocolatey

How to easily keep your GGU programmes up to date

Using the Windows package management system 'Chocolatey' (<https://chocolatey.org>), you can set up an automation process to ensure you always have the latest version.

To automatically install one, several, or even all GGU software packages via Chocolatey, proceed as follows:

1. You must uninstall any existing individual installations or the full installation of GGU software via the Windows Control Panel.
2. Open an MS Windows 'PowerShell' window as an administrator ('Run as administrator').
IMPORTANT: Please do not start the standard Windows Shell; ensure you use PowerShell (blue background !!).
3. Install Chocolatey by entering the following command in the PowerShell window:

```
Set-ExecutionPolicy Bypass -Scope Process -Force; [System.Net.ServicePointManager]::SecurityProtocol =  
[System.Net.ServicePointManager]::SecurityProtocol -bor 3072; iex ((New-Object  
System.Net.WebClient).DownloadString("https://chocolatey.org/install.ps1"))
```

1. Optional: In a PowerShell window running as an administrator, you can search for the GGU packages:

```
choco search ggu
```

```
choco search ggu-all-programs
```

```
choco search ggu-software-codemeter
```

1. To install the GGU software, enter the following command in the PowerShell window and press Enter:

For example, for GGU-STABILITY and GGU-RETAIN

```
choco install ggu-stability -y
```

```
choco install ggu-retain -y
```

```
... etc
```

or for all GGU programmes

```
choco install ggu-all-programs --timeout 0 -y
```

To install the latest CodeMeter User Runtime, enter the following command in the PowerShell window and press Enter:

```
choco upgrade ggu-software-codemeter -y
```

1. If you need to uninstall the software, enter the following command in the PowerShell window:

```
choco uninstall ggu-stability -y
```

... etc.

or

```
choco uninstall ggu-all-programs -y
```

1. Update your GGU installations using one of the following commands. During the upgrade, the old version will be automatically removed and replaced with the latest version.

```
choco upgrade ggu-stability -y
```

... etc.

or

```
choco upgrade ggu-all-programs -y
```

1. Subscribe to the Chocolatey newsletter under 'step 1' on the following website:

1. Alternatively, you can install future updates via the graphical interface using the Chocolatey GUI programme. To do this, follow these steps:

Enter the following command in PowerShell:

```
choco install chocolateygui -y
```

Now launch the Chocolatey GUI programme as an administrator. Everything else is self-explanatory.
